UNCLASSIFIED STUDENTS

Individuals are welcome to enroll for a limited number of classes as “unclassified,” non-degree seeking students if they have completed a high school degree or equivalency program and were in good standing at the last school or college they attended. Students interested in this option should complete the “Credit Registration Form for Unclassified Students.”

In order to change from this status to that of degree-seeking, students must make formal application for a degree status and submit transcripts from high school and each college previously attended. These should reflect better than average academic achievement. (Exchange students must provide documentation from their KCASE school.)

AUDITORS

Students classified as auditors are those who are taking courses for interest or the development of their own skills and not with the intention of seeking credit or a degree. Audit students are not required to do course work or to take examinations, but are expected to attend class regularly. It is not possible to change from an audit status to a credit status after registration. Course fees for credit and audit are the same. Students wishing to audit classes should apply as unclassified students.

VISITING STUDENTS

Students visiting Rockhurst from other institutions must certify that they are in good academic standing at their home institution and that they are eligible to register for the desired course(s).

FINANCIAL AID

Students visiting Rockhurst University as unclassified, auditors or visiting students are generally **not** eligible for financial assistance.

NOTE TO STUDENTS WITH DEFERRED LOANS

Providing your Social Security number to Rockhurst University is optional. However, your Social Security number is used to verify your enrollment to the government for loan deferment purposes. If you have a student loan that is in a non-payment status and you do not provide your Social Security number, your loan could go into an active payment status.
